In addition, America's leading beverage companies are directing the equivalent of \$400 million across the US, including investments in Florida to The Recycling Partnership and Closed Loop Partners to improve sorting, processing, and collection in areas with the biggest infrastructure gaps to help increase the amount of recycled plastic available to be remade into beverage bottles.
